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

Rules and Regulations

All drivers must attend a drivers briefing each day.

All karts must be scrutineered and have the scrutineer's sticker attached. A kart may be re-scrutineered at any time over the weekend. Karts may be also be scrutineered by Shenington's official scrutineer.

All drivers must sign on each day at race control, pay the relevant fee direct to Shenington KRC and show a BHKC club card. On the dummy grid drivers must show a fitted wrist band to the grid marshal before being allowed on to the track.

Drivers must wear suitable clothing and a modern helmet. These may be inspected at scrutineering.

On the track, drivers must drive with care and consideration to other drivers and all marshalls and flag signals. If the clerk-of-the-course deems your driving to be of concern you will be black flagged.

Noise levels will be monitored and if found excessive you will be black flagged. You will be required to reduce the noise levels of your kart before you are allowed out on the track again.

Owners allowing guests to drive their karts must ensure that the guest is competent and fully conversant with your kart and track details eg knowledge of flags and they must be signed on and have a wrist band.
